2010 HANDICAPS REVIEW

This has now taken place and members whose handicaps have altered will have been informed and new handicap lists are on the notice board in the changing rooms.

Since CONGU's recommendations in 2008 changed to just one review a year, the software now produces a list of those people with handicaps that they recommend should increase or decrease. The Handicap Committee members (men and women) then go through and assess each individual and the recommendations and make their decision. They also take into account any requests from individuals about whether their handicaps should be adjusted up or own.

The club is going to buy a defibrillator. Two members have generously contributed £500 each towards the cost of £1,950 + VAT and we hope to raise the rest with donations from members. If anyone wishes to donate to this worthy cause, please speak to the office. It will hang outside the clubhouse and in the event of someone suspected of having a heart attack you ring 999 and the NHS will give you the code to unlock the device. There are full spoken instructions to make sure that you do everything properly. We will post more details in the next newsletter. This equipment increases the chances of survival from a heart attack from 5% to 50%.
