 - [a] The player is penalised two strokes.
 - [b] The player loses the hole
 - [c] No penalty is incurred.

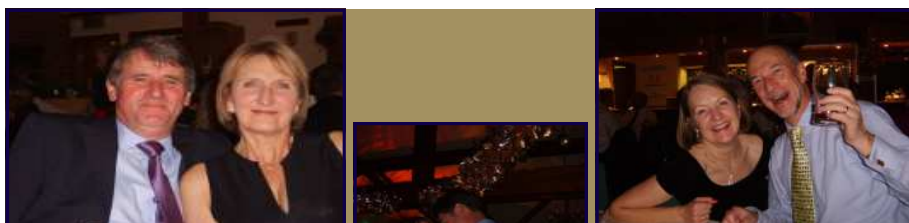
